ORDER

Considering the Motion for Expedited Consideration (Rec. Doc. No. 872) and the underlying Motion for Court Approval of Renewal Tax Election Limited to One Year Levy of the Tax for Continuation and Expansion of Hammond Accelerated magnet Program (Rec. Doc. No. 871),

IT IS ORDERED that the motion to expedite (Rec. Doc. No. 872) is **GRANTED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the underlying Motion for Court Approval of Renewal Tax Election Limited to One Year Levy of the Tax for Continuation and Expansion of Hammond Accelerated magnet Program (Rec. Doc. No. 871) is **GRANTED**, with collection of tax, assuming requisite voter approval, limited to one year.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Hammond Accelerated Magnet program may be expanded in school year 2010-11 to the seventh grade.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, absent court approval, commencing school year 2010-11 that accelerated magnet students and non-magnet students on the same grade level shall share lunch and recess

periods together without school-imposed separation of accelerated magnet and non-magnet students.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that playground equipment shall be equally utilized by accelerated magnet students and non-magnet students without regard to the procurement source of such equipment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, commencing school year 2010-11, no distinction shall be made between accelerated magnet students and non-magnet students in the area of transportation and parental drop-off and pick-up areas unless there are legitimate non-discriminatory reasons for any distinctions.
