

MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF
MOTION TO AMEND DESEGREGATION PLAN ORDER

The motion to amend the desegregation plan fully explains plaintiffs' request to amend. The plan should be amended to specifically make sure that defendants understand that the Tangipahoa Parish School System must make a good faith effort to eliminate the remnants of de jure racial segregation at all of its schools. To avoid future controversy, plaintiffs also request the court to make clear that the arbitration provisions which address personnel actions regarding teachers and administrators were not eliminated by its latest order. Plaintiffs also request the court to retain language citing the law that construction of schools and major improvements require defendants to submit a planning study and analysis to demonstrate the building programs effectuate the development and continuance of a unitary school system.
