**ORDER R. DOC. NO. 866 REPORT**

NOW INTO COURT, through undersigned counsel, comes Defendant Tangipahoa Parish School Board, who, pursuant to the court's Order (R. Doc. No. 866), presents its report on administrative level hirings. The following administrative level positions have been filled by the school board upon recommendations of the superintendent of schools:

1. Mildred Johnson, a black female, serves as Special Education Coordinator.
2. Levar James, a black male, serves as Director of Transportation and Risk Management.
3. Theresa Hamilton, a black female, serves as Title I Supervisor.
4. Gary Porter, a black male, serves as Assistant Principal at Hammond Eastside Upper Elementary School.
5. Joanna Roubique, a white female, serves as Assistant Principal at Champ Cooper Elementary School.
6. Gary Porter, a black male, serves as Assistant Principal at Hammond Eastside Elementary School.

7. The following recommendations by the superintendent of schools will be presented to the school board at its regularly scheduled meeting on July 20, 2010, for hiring: James Keith, a black male, recommended to become Principal at Hammond Westside Upper Elementary School; Terran Perry, a black male, recommended to become Principal at Natalbany Elementary School; Marcil Seal, a black female, recommended to become Principal at West Side Middle School; Chad Troxclair, a white male, recommended to become Principal at Hammond High School.
8. Prior to the Order, and during the period in which the prior Objective Criteria were not in use, the following administrative level appointments were made on or after November 2009: a) Corine Johnson, a black female, as Administrative Assistant at Hammond Westside Primary School; b) Jamie Mills, a black female, as Assistant Principal at Champ Cooper Elementary School; c) Samantha Robertson, a black female, as Assistant Principal at Hammond Westside Upper Elementary School; d) Hugh Wallace, a black male, as Assistant Principal at Hammond Eastside Primary Elementary School; e) Typhaena Lewis, a black female, as Assisstant Principal at Ponchatoula Junior High School.

Of the 14 administrative level positions either filled or recommended for filling subject to school board action on July 20, 12, or 86%, are for black professionals.
