**ORDER**

Before the court is Plaintiffs' Motion for Further Relief, requesting the immediate appointment of Mildred Johnson as Principal of Hammond High School. Subsequent to the filing of the motion and the scheduling conference with the court, the parties and Mildred Johnson engaged in discussions regarding new developments and considerations. After review of the pleadings, stipulations of the parties and Mildred Johnson, and applicable law,

IT IS ORDERED that Mildred Johnson shall be appointed as Principal of Amite High School;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the salary of Mildred Johnson in her new position as Principal of Amite High School shall be the same as the salary of the principal of Hammond High School, and she shall be entitled to receive the same increments and any other compensation that may hereafter be received by the principal of Hammond High School;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, notwithstanding any other orders and mandates of this court, Mildred Johnson shall have a right and first option to accept or reject the position of Principal of Hammond High School at the next vacancy of the position unless the court determines that the Tangipahoa Parish School Board has good and sufficient cause not to appoint her to the position at Hammond High School.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Thaisa Domiano shall be assigned to the administration of Amite High School to serve as an assistant principal for curriculum and such other responsibilities as may be assigned to her by the school's principal.

The court finds that Mildred Johnson's acceptance of the position as Principal of Amite High School furthers the goal of increasing the number of African-Americans holding positions as principals in the Tangipahoa Parish School System. This Order moots the necessity for hearing on plaintiffs' Motion for Further Relief (R. Doc. No. 895). The court observes, however, that Mildred Johnson has impressive credentials and she is well qualified for appointment as a principal within the Tangipahoa Parish School System.
