ORDER

Considering the Unopposed Motion for Declaration of Unitary Status in the Area of Transportation (Rec. Doc. No. 903),

**IT IS ORDERED** that said motion is **GRANTED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Tangipahoa Parish School System is hereby declared unitary in the area of student transportation, with the exception of transportation required for implementation of majority-to-minority and magnet transfers as provided for in the Order dated March 4, 2010 (Rec. Doc. No. 876). All other prior injunctions and orders entered herein directed to the area of student transportation are hereby vacated.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that judicial supervision of the Tangipahoa Parish School System in the area of transportation is hereby relinquished, with the exception of transportation required for implementation of majority-to-minority and magnet transfers as provided for in the Order dated March 4, 2010 (Rec. Doc. No. 876). Responsibility for all other such supervision is hereby returned to the Tangipahoa Parish School Board.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, with the exception of transportation required for implementation of majority-to-minority and magnet transfers as provided for in the Order dated March 4, 2010 (Rec. Doc. No. 876), this case is hereby **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** with respect to the area of student transportation. In all other areas of the operations of the Tangipahoa Parish School System subject to this Court's jurisdiction, the Court's jurisdiction and supervision are hereby retained.
