

## RESOLUTION

*In a regularly scheduled meeting of the Greater Tangipahoa Parish Branch NAACP #6058 held June 25, 2010, the following Resolution was offered, introduced and adopted by unanimous vote:*

**WHEREAS**, Carmon Moore is the Principal of Hammond High School where he has served for the past four years, during which time the NAACP has worked with Mr. Moore to resolve many student issues; and

**WHEREAS**, Carmon Moore is a 27-year-employee of the Tangipahoa Parish School System whose career has positively impacted the lives of many students, black and white, under his leadership and discipline; and

**WHEREAS**, many of these same students have grown up to become educated, dedicated and productive citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, Carmon Moore gives unselfishly of his time and service to the employees and students of Hammond High School, both at school and in the community; and


**WHEREAS**, Carmon Moore always exhibited a willingness to work for the betterment of students who had problems, when the NAACP asked that such be done, and has maintained an open-door policy in welcoming the NAACP to participate in problem resolution; and


**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Tangipahoa Parish, black and white, have voiced their support and respect for Carmon Moore's ability to lead faculty and to bring students together in the cause of education, to the ultimate benefit the students and the community; and

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Officers and Members of the Greater Tangipahoa Parish Branch NAACP #6058 offer this Resolution in support of reinstating Carmon Moore as principal of Hammond High School; and this organization requests respectfully that the Tangipahoa Parish School Board Members, Superintendent Mark Kolwe, and the Administration of the Tangipahoa Parish School System take the necessary steps to rectify an erroneous adverse personnel action committed against Carmon Moore by reinstating him as Principal of Hammond High School, an action which would (1) follow the Orders of the Court pertaining to hiring practices of the Tangipahoa Parish School System: (2) benefit the students of the Tangipahoa Parish School System and the community of Hammond, and (3) honor the outstanding service of Carmon Moore.
